

How to Record Your Voice with QuickTime

To record your voice, you will need the following:

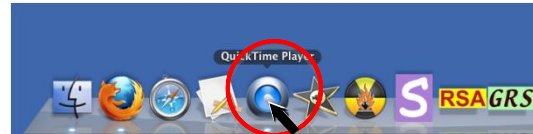
QuickTime software



Headphones with microphone

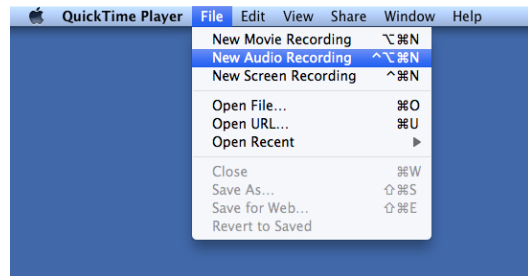


To record your voice, open QuickTime by clicking the **QuickTime** icon in the toolbar.

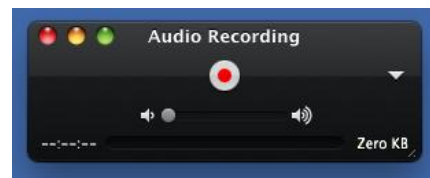


No window will appear.

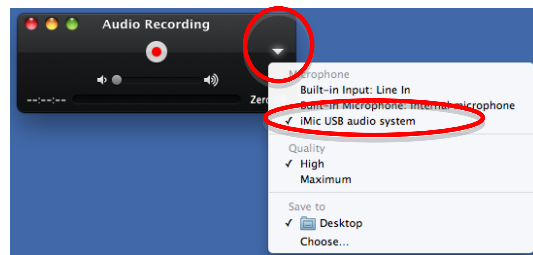
At the top of the screen, click on File and select **"New Audio Recording"**.



A new window will appear on the desktop.



Click on the **down arrow** on the recording toolbar for input options and select the "iMic USB audio system".



To record, simply click on the **red record button** on the recording toolbar.



When you are finished recording, click on the **stop button** on the recording toolbar.



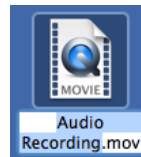
When you stop recording, a file with the extension “.mov” will automatically be created on the desktop.



You can rename the file by clicking on the icon once so that it is highlighted, then clicking on the name once.



You can then rename the file.



To listen to your file, click on the **play button** on the recording toolbar.
