

# QuickStart Guide for BTV

Note: The following instructions should work with the Pyro web cams in the Macintosh lab at the Robert Henderson Language Media Center. The result will be a QuickTime movie that can be played on either Windows or Macintosh.

To make a digital movie, you will need the following:



## To create the movie:

1. Quit (exit) from all other programs.
2. Double-click on the "Make a Digital Movie" folder.
3. Double-click on "BTV alias."
4. In the Capture Controls window, click on "Capture movie." The "Elapsed .." indicator is the signal that the recording has started.
5. Click on "Stop capturing movie" when you are finished recording.
6. The movie will appear in QuickTime Player.

## To compress the movie:

1. From the File menu at the top of the screen, select "Export..."
2. Click on the Options... button.
3. If you want both video and sound, make sure that both options are checked.
4. Video settings should be as follows:

Compression: Sorenson video
Quality: Best
Key frame rate: 15 or 24
5. If you have sound, use these sound settings:

Compression: IMA 4:1
Sample rate: 44.1 kHz
Sample size: 16
6. Click on OK
7. Give the movie a new name and note where it is saved.
8. Under "Export," make sure that "Movie to QuickTime Movie" is selected.
9. Click on Save.
