## How to Make a Digital Movie in the PC Lab

First, make sure that your computer station has a webcam.



Double-click on the “Make a Digital Movie” folder to open it.

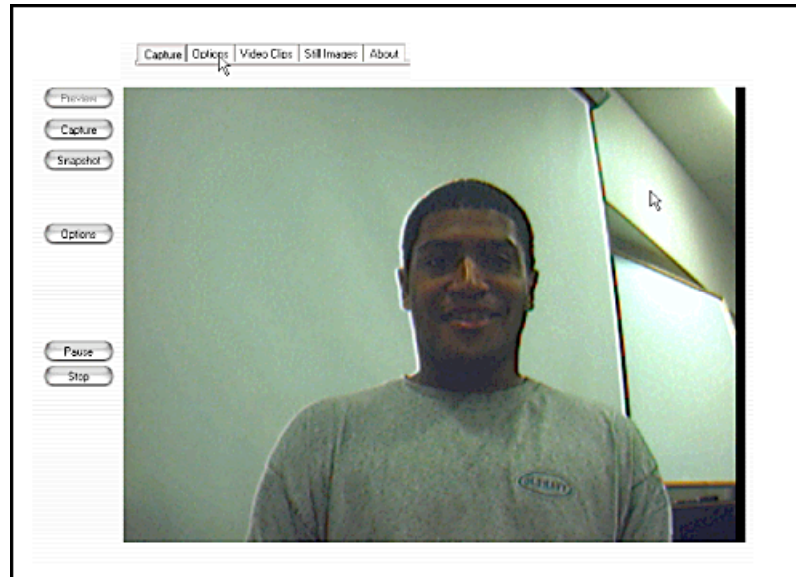


Double-click on “ADS Tech Camera View” to start the video capture software.

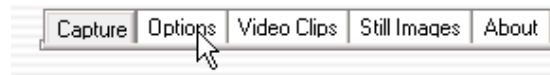

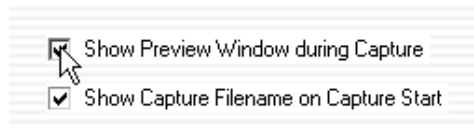
You should see a screen that looks something like this.



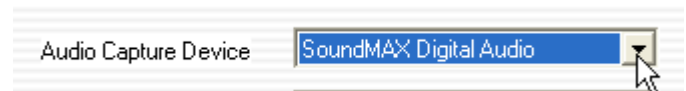
Click on the Options button at the top.



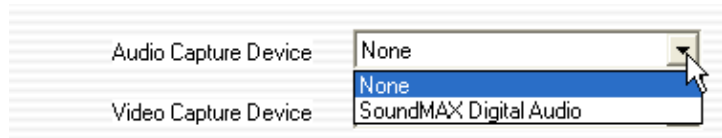
Check the box that says “Show Preview Window during Capture.”



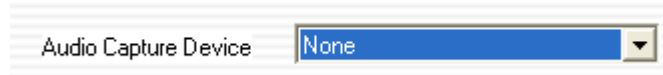
If you want your movie to have sound, check the Audio Capture Device setting. It should look like this:



If you want your movie to be silent, make sure that the sound capture is turned off. To do this, change the Audio Capture Device setting to None.



It should then appear like this:



Now click on the Capture button to return to the capture screen.



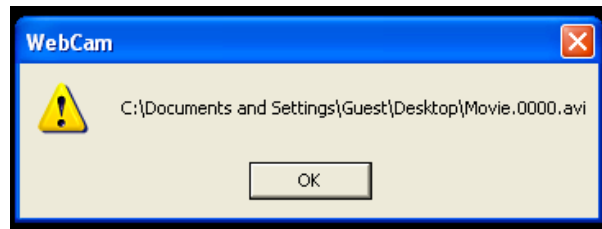
Now you are ready to record the movie.

Click on the Capture button on the left.

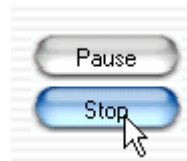


When you see this box, click on OK.

Record the movie.



Click on Stop when you are finished recording



Your movie file should appear on the desktop.

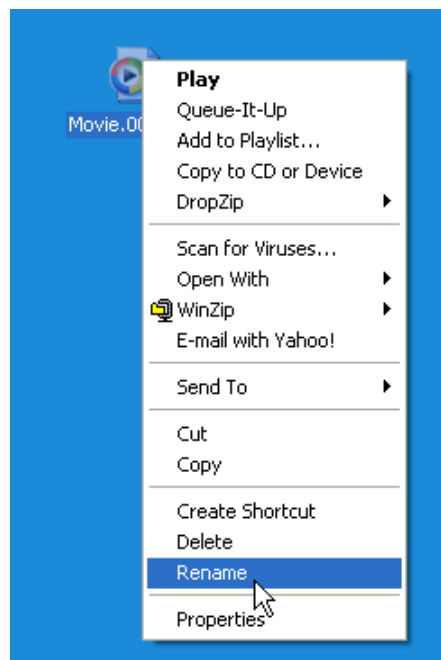


Double-click on the file, and it will open and play in Windows Media Player.



You will probably want to rename your file.

Right-click on the file icon. When a menu appears, select Rename.



Type in the filename of your choice.

Leave ".avi" at the end of the file.
